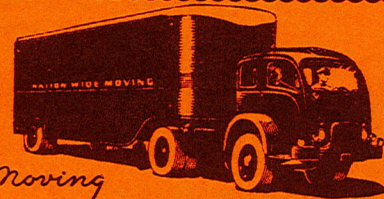

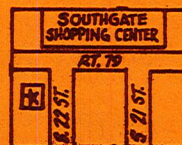

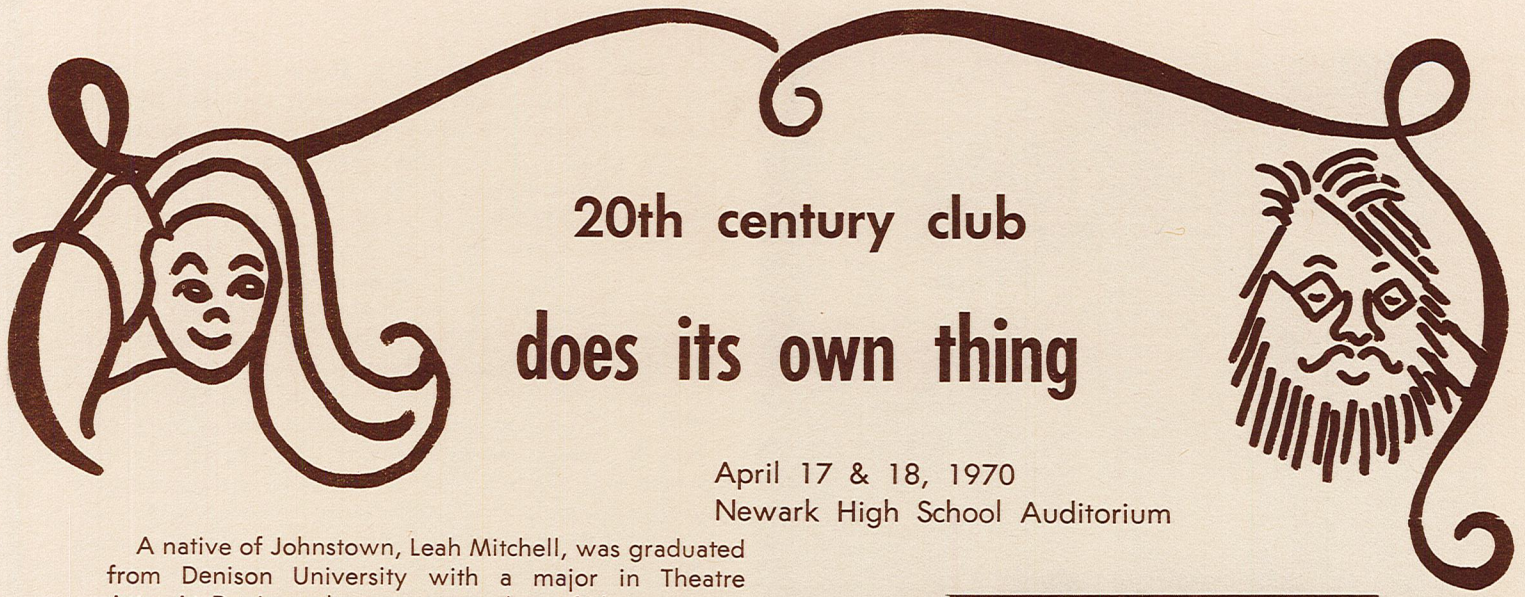

## 20th century club does its own thing

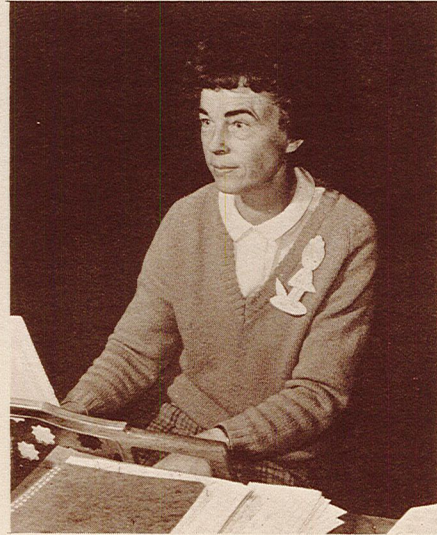
