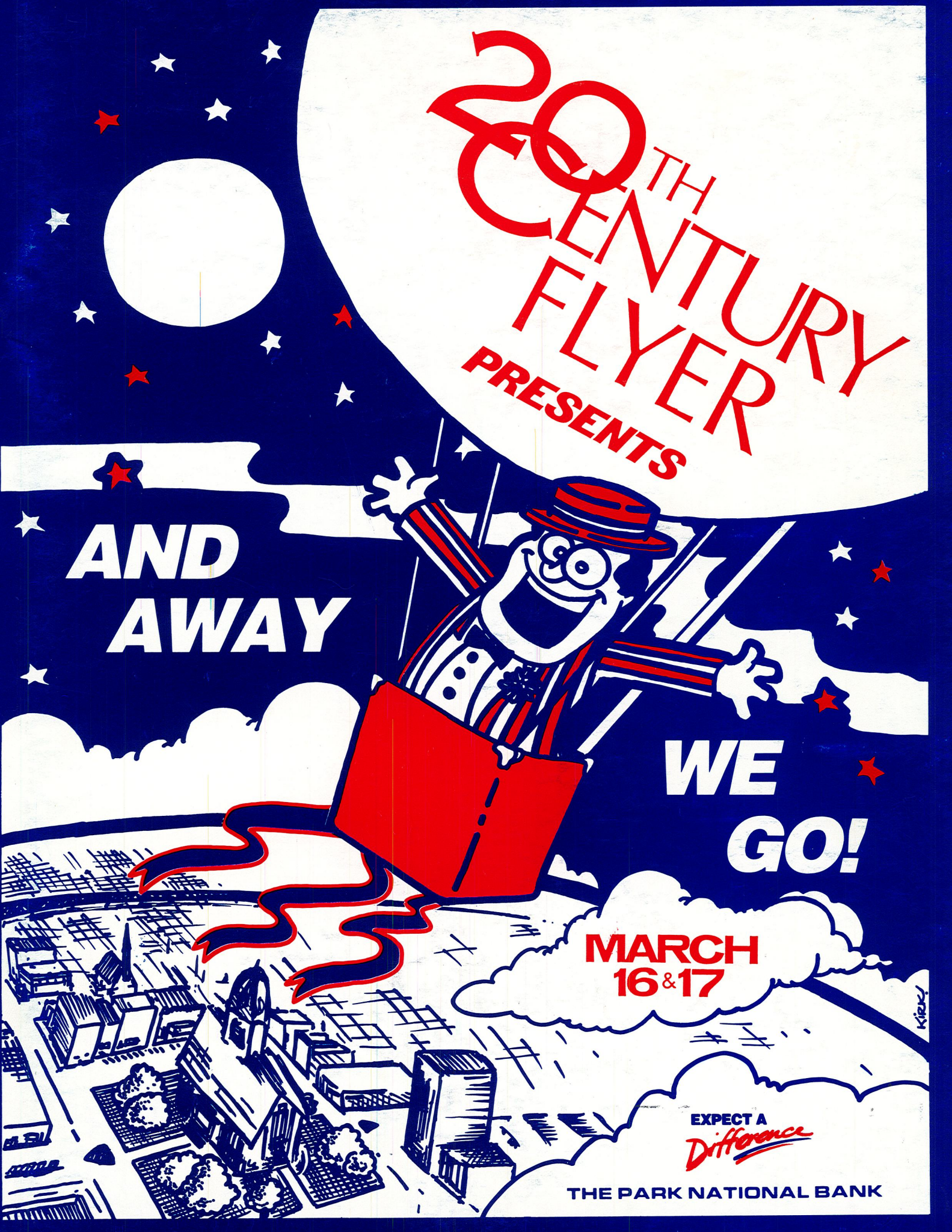

WELCOME!

Welcome to the 1990 Twentieth Century Flyer, "And Away We Go". We are pleased you could be with us tonite. We promise an evening of fun and entertainment.

For the past 77 years, your loyal support has enabled us to serve the children and adults throughout Licking County by our efforts at Camp O'Bannon and Licking Memorial Hospital. In 1989, over 10,000 hours were given by our club members in service and fund-raising.

In 1926, the Twentieth Century Club and the Newark Kiwanis sponsored a summer camp for selected children who are encouraged to feel good

about themselves by developing a positive self image. The experience has had a major impact on many young people. During the upcoming season, we plan to serve over 400 children at our two camp sites.

New this year is Project Venture. Project Venture is a ten week program to teach children, ages 11-14, basic living skills. The program consists of 8 modules, held once a week for 10 consecutive weeks, including one overnight recreational activity. The modules include: budgeting, employment, nutrition, safety, maintenance, clothes shopping, recreation and decision-making. The primary emphasis of this program is the hands-on instruction of day-to-day life skills.

Our members continue to contribute volunteer hours and money not only to Camp O'Bannon, but also give their time and resources to Licking Memorial Hospital by distributing books and magazines to hospital patients from our lending library cart. A new parent educational newsletter, Parent-Talk, which promotes their children's mental health is distributed by the club.

Other projects include our Annual Pro-Am Golf Tournament held in May each year. In November, we hold our annual holiday bazaar and we continue to market our cookbook. Our major source of income is the Twentieth Century Flyer.

The Twentieth Century Club members take this opportunity to express their appreciation to all of the angels, patrons, advertisers, audience and cast members for allowing us to continue our community service.

Thank you for coming this evening and please enjoy our show "And Away We Go".
