Good evening, and welcome to our show! As you take your seat in our audience, you become part of the Twentieth Century Club's eighty-year-old tradition of service to the Licking County community. In 1913 the Twentieth Century Club was founded by a group of ten girls still in grammar school. The girls grew up with the club, and the club has

grown up with Newark and Licking County. We now number over one hundred and twenty members.

As we celebrated our club's eightieth anniversary in 1993, I found it fascinating to read the old minutes of our organization. Besides reflecting the remarkable foresight of this group of young girls as they moved through their teen years and into womanhood, the journals also provide glimpses of the world and our community through the passing decades.

In 1917 we find the club members concerned with "funds for a Belgian war orphan" and preparing "two packages for the soldiers". Their earliest local project was a benefit garden party held at the home of Elizabeth and Mary Kibler, two of the original members. The funds raised helped furnish the "Baby Ward" of the new "City Hospital" being constructed. That hospital has come, and gone, and been replaced but the Twentieth Century Club is still here!

In 1923 the club members joined with the Phi Sigma Chi fraternity and the Newark Kiwanis Club in giving the first of many Charity Balls. This "dancing party" benefited a Fresh Air Camp for children who had had exposure to tuberculosis.

The minutes of the Twentieth Century Club are a peek into the past, often mentioning places and businesses no longer in existence. The club held dinners at the Warden Hotel on the east side of the square and sponsored bake sales at the "City Market" whenever a "market stall could be obtained". They bought countless blankets, shirts, and diapers from the John J. Carroll Department Store to supply the hospital nursery. In fundraisers with King's Department Store on the square, the club shared in a percentage of the store's daily profit. The members helped raise funds for the Community Chest, forerunner of United Way, and contributed to the "Elks' soup kitchen".

The Twentieth Century Club has helped the Fresh Air Camp evolve into Camp O'Bannon which now provides a positive summer camping experience for over three hundred and fifty selected Licking County children. We have continued to support Licking

Memorial Hospital in various ways through the years, and we assist the Mental Health Association in mailing a parent education newsletter each month. Our members participate in the United Way campaign by helping to arrange and serve the report luncheons.

The performance you are about to see had its beginnings in 1937 when the club members presented the first **Twentieth Century Flyer**. The show's title was a play on words since at the time there was a well-known train which used that name. Even though the railroad's **Twentieth Century Flyer** is no longer a household phrase, it's noteworthy that this production has existed long enough to have a title rooted in the heyday of train travel!

We appreciate your coming to our show this evening. Through the support of our audience, patrons, advertisers, musicians, technicians, and cast members, the Twentieth Century Club is able to continue its legacy of service to the community. We hope you will enjoy our Flyer — we present it in the spirit of fun and light-heartedness. However, the money we raise will be used judiciously and with great care, and as always, right here in Licking County.
