## Twentieth Century Club Works On Health Camp Preparations

Although the first session of the Licking County Health Camp opened June 17, 1963, work was begun by the members of The Twentieth Century Club in February to select the 144 children from Licking County who would attend.

Early in February applications for camp were distributed to the 18 elementary schools in Newark and 25 elementary schools in the county. From the recommendations and cooperation of principals and teachers, applications were returned for 329 children.

In March the parents of all the applicants were contacted to register their children for camp. A member of the Twentieth Century Club went to each county school to talk with the parents and register the children from that school.

Registration for city children was held in Central School. From the original applicants, registration was completed for 290 children.

On April 8 and 9, Health Camp Clinic was held in the offices of Drs. William and J. Halisey Kennedy. All the registered children were picked up at their schools and brought to the clinic, where they were given physical examinations and necessary inoculations.

We are especially grateful for the spirit of cooperation which exists between the two organizations, and anticipate 1964 will be the most productive year to date for children attending the Health Camp.

Mrs. William Barcus. Following clinic selection of the 144 children to attend camp was made and the remainder were placed on a preferential list. This was done with the assistance of teachers, principals, and nurses from the city and county health boards.

In May, each parent was notified if his child was to attend camp and which of the three sessions he would attend.

On Thursday, June 13, The Twentieth Century Club held the annual "Health Camp Day." This project is held the week before camp opens to make final preparation at the facility on O'Bannon Avenue for the open-

ing of camp. All the beds were made, clothing mended and placed in cabins, and staff quarters made ready for occupancy.

On the opening day of each camping session, each child was picked up at his home and taken to the camp, and three weeks later he was taken home again by the same person.

During the final week of each camping session, the club had another opportunity to see the campers in the form of a "treat-night party."

Our primary goal is to help prepare these campers to become better citizens of Newark and Licking County.

## 20th Century Club Role

The Twentieth Century Club takes a very active part in the activities of the Licking County Health Camp. Club members represent the club on the board of the Association, and at least 20 serve on the club's committee.

This committee has the following duties: distributing to city and county schools the application forms for Health Camp, holding a registration period in March for parents to sign up children for camp, conducting the clinic in April when all children must be examined by a group of doctors and given the necessary shots, selecting the boys and girls for the three camping periods, picking up and returning the children for their respective times at camp, hold-

ing a clean-up day after the opening of camp at which the cabins are readied and all supplies of clothing and bedding are distributed, taking a fall and spring inventory of all supplies and attending to the ordering of needed supplies, having a social hour one evening for each of the three groups at camp.

In addition to these activities with the boys and girls, the 20th Century Club undertakes special projects to improve the facilities of the camp. A year ago
