CAMP O'BANNON Our History

Camp O'Bannon has had an impact on Licking County families for over 85 years. It was started by the State of Ohio as a "Fresh Air Health Camp". In the late 1920's and early 30's, the operation was taken over locally by the 20th Century Club and the Newark Kiwanis Club. Camp O'Bannon was one of the original 6 United Way agencies. The support of these 3 organizations continues today. Camp O'Bannon was relocated to its present site in the 1950's and adjacent properties were acquired and original facilities completed.

Under the leadership of Joe Shaw, camp's first full time director, the Outpost Camp was started in 1976 and the current outpost property purchased by the 20th Century Club and T.J. Evans Foundation in 1979.


Since 1995, camp has undergone major facility and infrastructure improvements. All of the buildings have been repaired and improved. A beautiful new 2000 sq. ft. swimming pool was completed in 2002 and a much needed new bath house and laundry facility was built in 2007.

Our Campers

The mission, programs, and history of Camp O'Bannon come together each summer and are reflected in the smiling faces of the 400 Licking County children we serve. Ninety-five percent of these children have been referred by local school and social

service agency staff as those who would most benefit from our program. Over ninety percent of our children qualify for free lunches at school. For many of our children, Camp O'Bannon is their only summer vacation.


